WHY DO I NEED DAYCARE

We know for ourselves, that while our furry child adores us, we can't compete with the excitement he gets at being able to play with other four-footed friends and you'll be amazed at how tired a day of playing can make them. We know if you're looking, then you need a safe, fun environment for your dog/puppy when you can't be there. Somewhere where he/she can be kept dry when it's raining, get shade when it's hot, plenty of exercise and in general allow you to collect a happy, tired dog when you get back from work.

We know from our own furry child, that on weekends even if it is pouring outside, he still gets excited about the idea of walking and boredom results not only in a miserable dog, but also in half-eaten shoes, escape tactics and other destructive behaviour we don't otherwise see.



No matter the energy level of your dog, we can be the safe-haven your dog is excited to get to.

PUPPIES

Early socialization is very important and it's best to get your puppy used to other puppies and even large and older dogs before they reach what is known as the 'hazard avoidance stage', which for most breeds is around 14 weeks. Up until this stage everything and everyone is new and exciting and it's essential that your puppy has positive experiences in a safe environment.



At the same time, it's also very important to ensure your puppy does not come into contact with unvaccinated dogs and areas where unvaccinated and potentially sick dogs have been, before they have had at least 3 sets of DHPP inoculations. Canine Creche does not allow unvaccinated dogs and thus, like puppy training classes, we have always considered ourselves to be is a safe way to socialize young new furry children. Unfortunately, with the drought in the Western Cape, the Vets have seen a dramatic increase in the number of Parvo cases, many even in older dogs who are vaccinated and should be immune. As such we have had to stop taking in puppies before they have had at least 3 DHPP vaccinations and it's becoming a more common practice (encouraged by the Onderstepoort Veterinary Academic Hospital) for vets to give 4 DHPP vaccinations and not just 3.

Please note, the age your puppy receives all vaccinations varies on when the 1st was administered by the breeder. Some are done as early as 4 weeks, but the first is usually around 8 weeks of age.







Please Note: We unfortunately do not accept/enroll dogs or puppies needing daycare less than twice a week. The reason being that they find it difficult to find their place within the pack and each time they are with us need to 'reestablish' themselves, which

becomes similar to having to keep redoing their assessment day.

ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Enrollment is easy. Once you know we are the right fit for your family, simply read and sign the Service Agreement and fill in the Enrollment Form. These can both be found on the enrollment page of our website.

Once this is done, we need to schedule a day for your dog's temperament and behavior assessment. The cost of this day's daycare is R200.00. Unfortunately, you cannot be present while your dog is being assessed. We know this can be nerve racking, but we need to see how he/she behaves when you are not around in order to properly assess him/her.



DAYCARE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The purpose of the assessment is to ensure that your dog will fit in with the rest of the pack and doesn't have any undesirable behaviors that will pose a risk to humans, other dogs, or the daycare.

Undesirable behavior includes, but is not limited to, aggression towards any humans or animals, excessive barking or howling, and severe separation anxiety leading to escape attempts or very destructive behavior.

Unfortunately, as this is to ensure the safety of all furry charges and the longevity of the business, it is of the utmost importance and we have to be strict.

The other requirements for daycare attendance are more fully covered in the Service Agreement but include the fact that all dogs must be:

- 1. Up-to-date with their vaccinations
- 2. Dewormed regularly
- 3. Free of ticks and fleas
- 4. Spayed/neutered if older than 6 months
- 5. In good health
- 6. Wearing a collar with an identity tag containing their name and your contact number
- 7. Brought in and out of the daycare on a lead





CONTACTING US

Based on a survey that we ran over several months, we know that with flexi-time and/or long commutes to work, it is not always easy to fit into strict drop-off and pick-up times. We are thus open earlier than other daycares being from 06:00 to 18:00, Monday to Friday, excluding public holidays. Drop-off can be done anytime between 06:00 and 09:00, and collections are anytime between 15:00 and 18:00.

Whilst with our furry charges, we cannot always get to email and may occasionally miss calls. Please rest assured that we will get back to you, but it'll likely be after-hours.
